## GIN SELECTION

Gin is a liquor made from grain that has been infused with Juniper berries and other botanicals. Juniper berries, bluish berries with a piney flavor and aroma, are the predominant flavoring for all gin. The combination of botanicals, along with the production method, is what distinguishes one brand of gin from another. As its name indicates, dry gin is not sweet. It is usually aromatic and light in flavor and body.

Bourbon is a type of American whiskey made from corn. Another determinant is where it is produced - Whiskey from Ireland and U.S is usually spelled with the «e» contrary to whisky from Scotland, Canada, Japan and else-where which are spelled without «e». Couple that with varying distillation methods by country, region and producer, and you get a wide range of flavors from sweet to spicy and from smooth to bold and smokey.
